BOOK CORNER

Today Westminsterites are celebrating in the park. In *Presbyterians, a Spiritual Journey*, by Dick Wierenga, we can read of some of the many ways others in our denomination are living out their faith: the woman confirmed at age 16, now in her 90's and director of a youth center in Rochester, NY; the soldier assigned to South Korea, looking for ways to help his platoon, who got involved in mission work with the Korean people; the young Native American woman serving as a pastor who found a way to blend Christianity and tribal beliefs.
