CONGRATULATIONS TO REV. LYNN DAVIS on his 50-year anniversary of ordination! Please plan to join Rev. Davis's family at Westminster for a reception in his honor on **Sunday, Feb. 3**, from **2 to 3:30 p.m.**

Rev. Davis was ordained by Black Hills Presbytery of the Synod of South Dakota on Jan. 31, 1963, at his home church, First Presbyterian of Bison, S.D. His first call was to First Presbyterian of Atkinson, Neb. Four years later, he entered the U.S. Army Chaplaincy and served two tours in Vietnam. Following his military career, he served parishes in Minnesota, Nebraska, and North Dakota, as well as five interims in the Synods of Lakes and Prairies and Mid-America. Upon retirement, Rev. Davis has served as pulpit supply, Session moderator, and choir member. He has also volunteered in the community with various civic organizations.
