Dr. Osborne, head coach of the Nebraska football team for 25 years from 1973 to 1997, was one of the most successful and highly regarded coaches in college football history. He also served successfully as the Athletic Director at Nebraska at Nebraska until last January after serving six years in the U.S. House, representing Nebraska's 3<sup>rd</sup> district.
