### **Westminster Club- March 24- 5:30 pm**

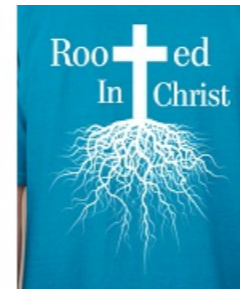
