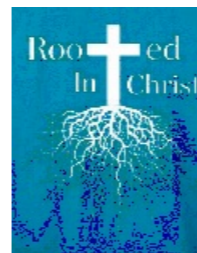
April 26 (10:15) Scottish Heritage Sunday
