## Lent: 40 Days of

Jesus spent 40 days in the wilderness, overcoming the temptations of the devil. Jesus was able to persevere because he grew strong in his relationship to God. His faith made his life take on clear focus. After the 40 days, his life changed and his true ministry began.

The Life Group Ministry invites you to focus on your faith this 40 days of Lent by joining a short-term small group. Using a reflection piece on the spiritual disciplines, each group will meet 6 weeks, usually one hour per week. It is an opportunity to grow in faith and friendship.

As Victor Hugo says in Les Miserable's, "The supreme happiness of life is the conviction that we are loved". God created us for community. In the first chapters of the Bible, it says that God breathed life into us, meaning that our very breath is given to us by someone else. And God says, it is not good for a human being to be alone (Genesis 2:18).

God intends people to be in relationships with others. The New Testament uses the Greek word *koinonia* 19 times to talk about church life. The *koinonia* experience is one of community, friendship, fellowship, sharing, partnership and teamwork. The spiritual presence of Jesus powerfully connected people together in the early church, and he can do so for us today.


