We are excited to host an evening of food and fellowship with Presbyterian Church (USA) Mission Coworker Jim McGill on Friday, June 2, at 6:30 p.m.

Westminster's Outreach Committee and our "World on a Plate" group are hosting the potluck supper, where Jim McGill will share about the work he and his wife, Jodi, have been doing in Malawi, Africa for 20+ years. Jim has worked in the areas of clean water and sanitation, with the Synod of Livingstonia's three hospitals, as well as the shallow wells work of the Marion Medical Mission.

Jodi McGill has been working with the Synod's three hospitals, the congregation-based malaria prevention program, HIV/AIDS prevention and care, and a variety of other public health programs. Jim and Jodi's next assignment will be to Niger, where they will be doing the same kind of work.

Jim spent many years in Africa doing geophysical research for the Geology Department at Duke, and as the child of Presbyterian missionaries to Congo. The McGills are the parents of six children, twins Jason and Michael, Salome, Selina, and twins Joseph and John.
