World Communion Sunday

Did you know the celebration of World Communion Sunday has its roots in the Presbyterian Church? It began in 1933 at Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, PA, under the ministry of Dr. Hugh Thomas Kerr, and by 1940 had begun to spread to Christian churches around the world.

Westminster will join on Sunday, October 7 with our sisters and brothers around the world in celebrating the Lord's Supper in a statement of interconnection and unity. The chapel and sanctuary will be decorated with flags from around the world. During 10:30 worship, the Westminster Choir will sing Famine Song, a stirring anthem depicting the famine that gripped Sudan during the 1980s.

Creation Challenge for October Challenge yourself to reduce the amount of junk mail you receive.

Here are some steps, from Westminster's Green Team, to reduce the volume of unwanted mail:

In just 4 steps, you can help make a difference in saving paper and the planet!

Call **1-888-567-8688** or visit <u>www.optoutprescreen.com</u> and choose not to get offers for new credit cards and insurance. It is reported that this venue is more effective against junk mail than the "Do Not Call Registry" which has not been very effective against spam phone calls. This also helps to prevent fraud, if a credit card offer falls into the hands of a criminal.

Visit www.dmachoice.org and the Data Marketing Association will allow you to opt out of Categories of mail, such as unsolicited catalogs. This has a \$2 fee, but will block most unwanted DMA mail for 10 years.

Do not enter contests, the purpose of which is to obtain your name and address for direct mailers or to sell you something.

Be aware that in most cases you do not have to fill out a warranty card to benefit from the warranty. The card is a jackpot of information that is often sold to other companies who want to market products to you. Read the card carefully to determine whether you must return it. You can, in most cases, also check a box that says "Do not send me unrelated offers or share my name with other marketers."
