Purpose:

The Swanson Scholarship Fund was established in 1999, by Libby and Steve Jacobs of West Des Moines, Iowa, daughter and son-in-law of Bill and Mary Swanson of Lincoln NE. The Swanson Scholarship Fund is a generous expression by the donors of their faith in Jesus Christ and the importance of continuing education to the Christian life. The scholarship provides financial support for the undergraduate education in the amount of \$500 per recipient per academic year.

Qualifications:

The qualified applicant is an active member of Westminster Presbyterian Church or has a parent/guardian who is an active member of the church. The applicant is either currently enrolled as a full-time student in undergraduate education or has been admitted for full-time study in an accredited institution of higher education for the year in which the scholarship is to be given.

While the scholarship is open to all courses of study, preference will be given to an applicant who demonstrates an interest in a course of study related to Education and Community Service.

Renewal:

Renewal of the scholarship for subsequent years of full-time undergraduate study is not mandatory or automatic but will be considered by the selection committee. The recipients may request renewal of the scholarship by written request and evidence of continued enrollment in good standing with a minimum full-time GPA of 3.0 or its equivalent.

Application Process:

Application forms for the Swanson Scholarship Fund are available from Westminster Presbyterian Church. Applications and renewal requests will be received through March 31. Notification will be given after April 30.
