

## **Current Guidelines Update**

Westminster's Session has approved a mask requirement for worship and other activities on campus. Acknowledging that many of you have been wearing masks as a precautionary measure on your own accord, we felt that with (1) the rise in COVID cases locally (2) a faith-based concern for our children and the immune-compromised among us, and (3) several recent "break-through" cases amongst our church family, it was time to affirm this practice once again. LLCHD's reinstating of a mask requirement locally this week reflects our session's embrace of science and local knowledge throughout the pandemic. For the time being, we also encourage resisting physical contact with each other. Our Sanctuary Task Force will continue to assess week-to-week, with authority to relax precautionary measures as needed. Session will continue to vote on any measures that strengthen precautions, as indicated by our vote Monday night. We continue to give thanks for your patience, grace, and dedication as we navigate the ongoing nature of COVID-19 in our world.
