Eco-Palms

In celebration of Palm Sunday, Westminster has partnered with the Presbyterian Hunger Program to use Eco-Palms. Eco-Palms are harvested in a sustainable manner from local community farmers such as Anna Sentana, who lives in Carmelita, Guatemala. As we raise our branches today, we play an important role in protecting forests, local jobs, and sustainable livelihoods in harvesting communities. Westminster is a certified PC(USA) Earth Care Congregation, one more reason for us to celebrate Palm Sunday in a sustainable and responsible manner.

Liturgist? A word that can seem lit-erally confusing!

Liturgy - it's one of those church words that can be confusing and seem "insider-y." So, what does it mean? The word "liturgy" translates loosely from its Greek origins as "the work of the people." In worship, we often refer to the different written-out parts as "liturgy." Our use of this word can be an important reminder that worship is a living and vibrant act of our church and community, not simply a task of our pastors. For several years our Deacons have shared in writing prayers and other parts of worship, and now that opportunity is being expanded to our Elders and others who are interested in this area of leadership. Pastor Chris will stay in the sanctuary following worship today to answer your questions and share more about liturgist opportunities at Westminster.
