- **Service:** Hands-On Mission Projects and Service-Learning Opportunities, both at church and off-campus. Details to be shared monthly. (Wednesdays of September 21, October 12, November 16)
- **Connection:** Opportunities for "just fun," such as all-church cornhole on September 28th, casual "table talk" for adults, Spooktacular community event on October 26, and one "Parents Night Out" connection dinner for parents at a local restaurant this semester (details TBD).

**September 14 (Wednesday Kick-Off) –** Living the Faith Class / Children and Youth activities meet separately.

**September 21** – Hands-on Mission Project (options being explored for Fall include packing school supply bags at church, visiting the Habitat Re:Store, and more! Children and Youth activities may meet separately, depending on project.

**September 28** – Churchwide Cornhole Tournament (all ages together for a one-hour minitournament!).




center of the film and can choose which direction to look, making it a truly immersive experience. Group console games will also be available.

- The clean-up team will continue sorting, so check Cole Hall often.


