Featured Preacher and Lecturer

Dr. Martha Moore-Keish

J.B. Green Professor of Theology

Columbia Theological Seminary, Decatur, GA

Dr. Moore-Keish is the J.B. Green Professor of Theology at Columbia Theological Seminary. She holds an undergraduate degree focusing on comparative religions from Harvard College, an M.Div. from Union Presbyterian Seminary in Richmond, and a Ph.D. in theological studies from Emory University. Before joining the faculty of Columbia in 2004, Dr. Moore-Keish worked in the PC(USA) Office of Theology and Worship, developing resources and educational events for church leaders, and was Assistant Professor of Liturgical Studies at Yale Divinity School and the Institute for Sacred Music.

Dr. Moore-Keish has published books on eucharistic theology and prayer, a theological commentary on the book of James, and an edited volume, Karl Barth and Comparative Theology. Dr. Moore-Keish recently served as Reformed co-chair of the international ecumenical dialogue between the World Communion of Reformed Churches (WCRC) and the Vatican's Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity. Martha met and married her husband Chris at Union Seminary. They have two young adult daughters, Miriam and Fiona, two cats, and one enthusiastic dog.
