REMINDER TO IRA OWNERS AGE 70 ½ OR OVER: QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTIONS ARE GREAT OPTIONS FOR MAKING TAXFREE GIFTS TO the Westminster Foundation.

IRA owners age 70 ½ or over can transfer up to \$100,000 to Westminster Foundation (or other charities) tax-free each year. These transfers, known as qualified charitable distributions or QCD's, offer eligible older Americans a great way to easily give to the Westminster Foundation.

Normally, distributions from a traditional IRA are taxable when received. With the QCD's, however, these distributions become tax-free as long as they're paid directly from the IRA to an eligible charitable organization like Westminster Foundation.
