At this event, we'll join with friends from Homestead, Missouri River Valley, and Central Nebraska presbyteries to explore the following questions:

- As Christians who believe that God's love truly extends to all people, how can we show true hospitality to anyone who walks through our church doors, especially members of the LGBTQIA+ community?
- We've said we're welcoming, but how can we show this welcome beyond the walls of our churches and offer God's love to the broader community?
- At Covenant Conversation: Nebraska, we'll worship, learn, and converse together about how we can live into a "new day" in the church and renew our commitments to witnessing to God's love for the whole world.

The Mission focus for August is Willie's Underwear Project. This project was started by Willie Shafer, a long-time member of Westminster.

Sadly, Willie is no longer with us, but her legacy continues. Willie's Underwear Project is exactly what it sounds like - providing underwear and sweatpants and t-shirts and socks to school nurses and counselors for when a student is ill at school or has an accident and needs a change of clothes to be able to return to class. Sometimes a parent can't be reached, or the parent can't get a change of clothes to the school quickly or a change of clothes just isn't available in the household at the time. This would mean the child has to sit in the nurse's office until a solution is found.

You can donate items in the bucket at the top of the stairs near the 27th Street entrance or give a gift card or check to the Westminster Office. If giving a check, write Willie's Underwear Project in the memo line. Mission/Outreach thanks you for your generosity.
