
## Calvin Crest Fun Day


## Presbyterian Women's Annual Kick-off



Thank you for taking time out of your day to be with me.

After sharing my goals for the next year, several members asked how they could better support me. I said by just being a friend, talking to me and being patient with me.

But then my friend Amy Taft, a State of Nebraska HHS service Coordinator, told you about the Enable Savings Account Gifting Program. I have had an Enable account for a long time and you can gift to my account.

#### If you remember, my goals are:

- 1. Buying that Shiny Blue Truck by April 2025 for PooPatrol so my support staff won't have to drive me all over Lancaster County scooping yards in their cars. My goal is \$35,000. I have saved in my PASS Plan for the last 2 1/2 years \$26,000.
- 2. Albert Noah Pooper and I are going the 5 modules of Service Dog Training. Albert and I are in the middle of Module 1 right now. Each module costs \$1500.
